It's the Law: Specifically for PWC Operators

- Everyone on board a PWC while underway must wear a Coast Guard Approved Vest
- An operator of a PWC equipped with a lanyard type ignition safety switch must attach the lanyard to his or her person, clothing, or PFD
- A PWC may not tow a water skier or a person(s) on a similar device unless:
 1. The PWC Manufacturer-approved seating for at least three people and
 2. There is a vacant seat for the skier and
 3. An observer, in addition to the operator is on board.



Remember-there are age and boater education requirements for PWC Operators. Please check with the New Mexico State Boating Regulation Safety Guide on-line if you are in doubt about any of these requirements.
