Winter Store Hours Morgan Marine Inc. will start closing the store on Sunday beginning on October 1st, 2011 and will continue through March 1st, 2012. We will be available Tuesday through Saturday 8:00am until 5:00pm. Our service center will return any calls that are received during non-store hours on the following Tuesday. You may contact us by fax @ 575-894-6986 to request service on your boat. This helps our employees to have time to get re-acquainted with their families after the long summer run and saves on the fuel bills to heat this large facility.

The Winterizing Notice will be posted on our website should you need another copy or you may phone us and we will see that one is faxed to you. No work will be done without a signed authorization. As you know many people ignored the winterizing for their boats last winter with devastating results. Weather is certainly unpredictable so please be prepared.

Changes for Our Website with the economy affecting everyone's bottom line we have made the decision to discontinue the mailing of our newsletters. It will be available on the website on a quarterly basis (with back issues for one year). Please check there often for special events, fishing reports, and any other activities that may be of interest. There are links to most area attractions also. 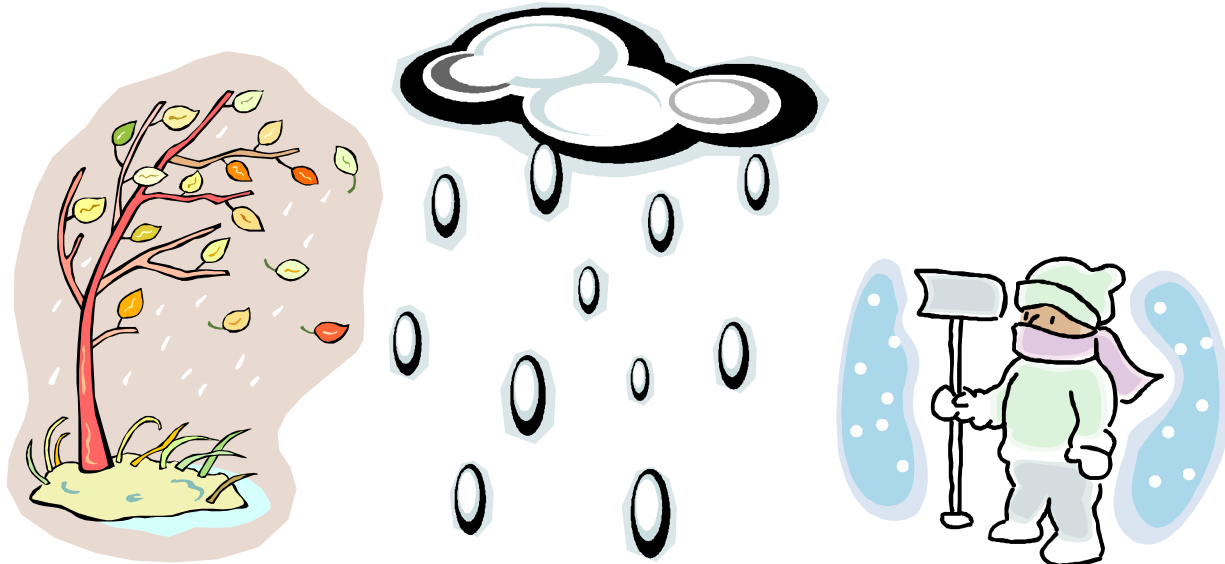

Winterizing Changes and Other Special Notices: Please note that the Service Department has been bogged down with an extra heavy load this year and therefore we must make a few changes to “free up” their time:

1. All telephone calls to discuss service with a mechanic will require you to leave a call-back number. This is not to eliminate your contact but to allow him time to complete whatever task he has “in progress”. Our counter personnel are very well informed; please discuss your needs with them whenever possible.
2. If you store your jet skis or other recreational items in front of your boat, you will be responsible with delivering the boat to Morgan Marine Inc. for service and returning it to your storage facility.
3. All customers arranging pick-up service by Morgan Marine Inc. will be required to provide keys to the storage unit and the boat. We will mail them back when the service is completed and the bill is paid. Your property managers are not always available to allow us to have access in a timely fashion, so we will have to make 2 trips. Sorry for the inconvenience, time is such an issue.
4. Special Winterizing rates listed below are good thru December 1st, 2011. After that date all parts and labor will be billed at regular rate.
5. There will be a pick up and delivery charge on any service order when Morgan Marine Inc. is requested to pick up your boat for service.
6. All service will require a signed authorization. This is not a new policy, only a reminder. Please fax or mail it immediately.
